- Updating and editing rare plant information and data: Ongoing updates to plant details such as taxonomy, listing status, blooming period, elevation, habitat/microhabitat, notes, and threats. Continuous review for new or updated plant information from online resources/databases, CCH1/2, publications, and data submissions to the CNDDDB.
- Developing and implementing the status review process: Maintaining the backlog of plants proposed to undergo addition, change, or deletion to California Rare Plant Ranks in the RPI.
- Updating and maintaining the RPI database and web application: Finding and fixing bugs, maintaining functionality with updated operating systems and browsers, maintaining third party links and map plugins. Includes database/web programmer contracting fees.
- Advancing the RPI database and web application: Continuous research and advancement to bring new features, new content, and additional search capabilities to the RPI. Includes database/web programmer contracting fees.
